Wheter she creates a performance, installation or a painting, the artist never stops exploring the caracteristics and the possibilities inherent to the water, earth and meteors. Her interest for these elements goes hand in hand with a peticular reflexion on the process to give shape to her ideas. Having participated in exhibitions in Brasil and other foreign borders, her works are presented today in collections such as the Gilberto Chateaubriand Collection in Rio de Janeiro, the Modern Art Museum of São Paulo and the Center for Contemporary Art Inhotim in Brumadinho, Minas Gerais.




Marcela Ferrero

Born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, in 1965. She lives and works in Geneva.

Marcela Ferrero is a graduated archictecture student of the University of Buenos Aires. (1984-1989). She was promoted with a special mention in the theme of geometrical composition with letters. In 1986-1988, she studied Fine Arts with the professor: Lidia Caceres. She attended the courses of Hacques Manley, professor in the School of Fine Arts of Nice. Currently installed in Geneva, she practices painting since she arrived in Switzerland, thirty years ago.

The notions of indoor – outdoor, occult and light caracterises a big part of her works. Her artistic approach reminds the importance of reaching and reveal the innerself that leads to individual growth. This process, Marcela, chosed it to be placed in the universe of the sea. Place of relaxation, introspection, inspiration where she feels connected to a vital energy, indispensable for the creation of her works.
